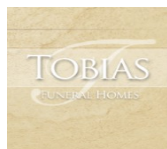

Voted in all at once tonight which was OK'd by membership. Frank reinstated 10 members since last mtg, along with new members voted in tonight, gives us a grand total of 486 members. Drew Titone led guest out before the Treasurer report.

Treasurer report Charlie Rigano reported the balances and listed major expenses for both John Pirelli. Gloria Marano motioned to accept the report. Seconded. Motion approved.

Charlie made a motion: To take advantage of Money Market Account interest rates within each of our two WPCU accounts, the Treasurer may move money among checking, share and money market without specific approvals for each movement, and report all movements since the previous such meetings at the next council and membership meetings. Seconded by: Maria Napier Tony Perfilio made a motion to amend Charlie's motion, The intent is to keep the maximum amount of money in the Money Market and only move to checking as needed. Seconded. 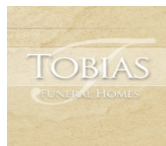
