

A big THANK YOU to the Piave Fiume Lodge (who, we are told, will be doing another event, "Trivia Night" for the same charities.

Even though many of our Grand/filial lodges are a distance from the GMM, we can still do our part to shoulder a portion of the financial burden which is incumbent upon us as "joint owners." If your lodge is interested in any of the above fund-raising ideas, please reach out to us, and we will put you in touch with the chairpersons who can direct you to the resource. Likewise, if your lodge has run a successful fundraiser (not just for the GMM), please reach out to us so that we can share this in the newsletter (pictures would be great, too!).
