It will be the only one in Ohio to transport whole blood to be able to start transfusions immediately. This cause is near and dear to the Baldasares, as their grandson was in a catastrophic car accident several years ago, and his life was saved due to CareFlight getting him the hospital quickly. He graduated from Bowling Green State University last year! CareFlight serves a 13-county area and will go to OSU or UC if needed. Joe also adds that a Lodge Member, Pete Lanasa, is in hospice care- please keep him in your prayers.
