- ROLL CALL – Niki: All present except Andy Militello (excused absence).
- PAST MEETING MINUTES – (Revisions or changes? Accept into record.) None- Accepted into record.
- COMMUNICATIONS – Niki: None
- FINANCIAL SECRETARY REPORT – Frank reports no new applicants. We currently have 484 members.
- TREASURER’S REPORT – (Guest escorted out of the room by our guard, for this portion of the meeting). Charlie shared details on all accounts, balances, and expenditures for both JP and Societa while the guest was out of the room. Motion to accept report into record by Fred Ferrara. Seconded by Jim Balsamo. Discussion: None Voted: Yes- unanimously
- MEMBERSHIP REPORT – Sharon and Marisa do not have anything currently.
- STATE UPDATE – Jack shared that the 57th bi-annual convention took place several weeks ago. There was a great representation from our lodge. The President and VP position will remain the same. Many new officers are from John Pirelli. Financial goals for the state include membership recruitment and retention. In 2024, there was a total loss of eighty-six members throughout the state. In 2016, there were 2997 members. Today there is 1938 members statewide. Electronic voting was approved at the state convention. The state purchased a program to allow all lodges to vote electronically and remain secret. We need to look at this for our lodge. Are we still the largest in state lodge? Yes, AND top 10 in the country. Shawn Powers adds thoughts around the loss of membership. He explained that the birthrate in Europe (Italy) is 1.2. 2.2 needed to sustain a culture. Our membership is reflective of what is going on. Shawn encouraged all to ask all who we know are of Italian descent, if they are members and encourage them to join! Thank you, Maria Rzecznik for organizing such a wonderful service for Fran Franchina. Jack adds that at the membership breakout session during the convention, the question of “Average age of members attending monthly meetings” was asked? An aging membership appeared to be a common theme. Maria Rzecznik asks why the drop? Jack shared lots of issues over 10 years (deaths, moving etc).

● **TREASURER'S REPORT** – Charlie reported under JP meeting due to guest being out of the room.

* **Buildings and Grounds:** Scott Davis thanks Maria Rzczeknik for weeding. We also thank JB and husband Scott for power washing the ramp and some of the concrete, the tables etc. They were here at least 6 hours. THANK YOU. Mark Warner adds that we repaired much of the paver areas. Thank you to Dan Duff, Dan Bruno, Andre Tagliamonte, Steve Torre, Jim Balsamo, Tom Varney and Mark Warner for the help! Sweeper on the bocce courts... Sweeper is old and broken and difficult to find replacement parts. Mark is trying to fix. Greg Sorice spent all day Saturday replacing all of the bocce court lights and 8 parking lights! Thank you!

Finance Committee-Sharon adds this is an appropriate time to reinstate the finance committee. Charlie reports on the investment account, which is like an endowment where principle stays intact and interest compounds. Earnings will be spent off that. We want to preserve our heritage and culture, despite FESTA. With that in mind, how can we strategically make that happen? Sharon did a 15-year projection, taking into account upcoming expenditures with building beautification projects. It would take about 2.2 million to be self-sufficient. This could take 10-15 years to get there, depending on projects, key assumptions etc. We want to continue making smart, informed decisions. The committee will be meeting and reporting back to membership. Alternative sources of revenue will be reviewed also. Maybe a fundraising committee too. The goal is to cover operating expenses, then monies going to other "pots of money." Fred Ferrara asks who is on the committee? All of the current officers as well as Sharon Smith. Mark Warner asks if we can start to publish who is on all committees? This can be added newsletters and add to the website.

* Festa: Jim- 48th annual Festa Sept 5,6,7. Booth Chair Booth Chair meeting is Tuesday, July 15 at 7:00pm

Booth chair list was emailed out. A revised/ correct version will come with next newsletter. Fred Ferrara chairs the booth that feeds the volunteers and needs HELP.

Lodge Beautification Program- Jim Balsamo explains about the project. The recommended plan was presented to council and they decided to take a "phased in" approach to the projects (Do what is needed first). This includes replacing the roof (remove old) and put on dimensional shingles (still picking color), new gutters, new downspouts, fascia, and soffits. Stucco the outside of building to give more of an Italian look. A new mural will also be done with the new logo-including Sons and Daughters of Italy. There are currently three bids. Two are close in cost and one is higher. Jim Balsamo makes a Motion for \$91,000 to do the roof, stucco, and mural/ artwork. For the one bid that is higher, if we feel the need to go with that bid, Jim will come back to the membership to ask for more money. Seconded Mark Pinti. Discussion: Gloria reminded that with the financial projection, we did put in \$100,000 for this year, as well as money for next year to do the interior. Pete Petrini asks can we just do a "Not to Exceed" amount for the highest bid, so you do not have to come back in the event that is the bid we go with? No- Jim is confident with the \$91,000. This total also includes a \$7500 contingency. Fred Ferrara asks about timeline. Jim shared this would begin right after Festa. The roof taking about 3 days, and the stucco work about 2 weeks. Linda Fischbach asks to select colors representative of our culture. Are we planning to do shudders? Jim is asking 3- 5 members to help with the color selection. How will this effect day-to-day operations? Not too much if at all. The stucco will have some scaffolding, but this should not be an issue. Work will not shut the lodge down. Shawn Powers thanks the committee for this work and asks if there is a guaranteed workmanship? Jim is seeking this. Maria Rzecznik confirms we will not be expanding? Correct. Currently, this lodges does not owe any money. Jim shared a bit of history of how the lodge was in financial distress and how we will not allow that to happen again. VOTED (by a show of hands) YES unanimously. No hands raised for "No" vote.
