Caitlin Davis is a FOTO rep, Katie Swiger- FOTO chair, Eldora Perfilio is the Italian Relations chair; Gloria Marano is on the National Arbitration Committee; Tony Perfilio is the National Orator; and Brian Andzik is the 3rd National Vice President. This makes Brian the highest ranking person ever in the history of Ohio and the John Pirelli Lodge. That means that in 2031, the National President could very likely will be Brian! Jack Giambrone is now the National Trustee.

* **Jack updates on the Bylaws.** Jack shared that 8 bylaw items were to be voted on. 7 made it to the floor for vote and 1 was recalled. 4 were passed and 3 defeated by vote.

Brian highlighted our great presence with FOTO (sub organization focusing on the advancement of younger members). Brian adds we need to be more appealing to younger folks, more nimble etc. Ohio also collected a lot of funds for Charity and encourages us all to be proud of what we are doing here in Ohio! New lodges were formed in Sicily and Rome. Pres Trump will be making a proclamation to make October Italian Heritage Month and recognition of Columbus Day. Brian has been invited to this signing! He has also been invited to meet the Pope! Brian is already involved in many meetings at National level is very busy. Lodge Beautification Program Jim updates that Gloria has signed the contract with First Onsite. Tentative start date is Sept 21st. The color committee has preliminary choices and we are working to get a rendering to show members.

Festa update-Brian thanks everyone for their work to bring the 48th festa together. Booth chairs stood for recognition and folks were encouraged to see them to sign up for a shift. Volunteers are still needed. Marcus Levin is our NEW IT chair! We will trial use of credit cards this year in a few booths and Friday Lunch. If successful, we'll use more next year. We'll still have ATM's. Parking and police will have same format. Reynolds and Reynolds is a great place to park for ALL of us (use shuttle). Please be nice to the POLICE. We'll be focusing on Public Safety more so this year. Barricades will be set up to help protect people. There will be an additional police officer also in effort to be proactive. It is unlikely that we'll have aprons this year. They are hard to get and expensive, so please bring your own apron. Food products have been able to be sent back historically if we have not used, but this is no longer. It will be important to use only what we need so we have accurate count for next year. Prices won't increase except for Wine due to tariffs. Thanks for helping set up! There are some yard signs left-,please grab tonight and remember they can be used for many years. Michelle Tagliamonte asked if there will be signs advertising taking credit cards at the booths. It would be a good idea, and other booths can make own signs that say "cash only." Marcus shared he is working with our Square rep. We are paying the credit card fees at this time and should not make much difference. Question to Marcus around use of apple pay/ use of phone, not just the credit card? Square accepts physical cards, Apple pay, Android pay, and Cash App. Marcus shared he'll be in the booths for training and support throughout the weekend. Square will be used for the Friday lunch, meatball, calzones, and merchandise booths. Will there be news advertising? Brian has reached out to Living Dayton and is awaiting a response. We've sent out a press release in the past, Joe may be able to help with this. Digital, Facebook and IG are providing the best results. Jim adds that the booth chairs have parking passes but please use R&R whenever possible. NO LEFT HAND TURNS IN/OUT of the grounds. Placement of booths and putting tops on will be this weekend. Thank you in advance for help. We need your help Monday after Festa to put things away.
