* Buildings and Grounds: Scott D updates about the stucco progress, and the artist did start the mural. Scott plans to review the project list w/ Drew in order to get new prices etc. We spent \$26,000 last year- getting quite a few things accomplished. We will not be doing much work over the winter. Please keep in mind that there will be a Spring clean-up and volunteers will be needed. Drew shares that our alarm system in the annex/ garage is off/ no power. One outlet is dead and a fridge is out too. Please see Drew if you know anything about this and can help. Did we check the circuit breakers? Yes. All are active. Charlie shares our security people will come out if needed. It is likely power. Both key-pads are dead.

Lodge rentals-Hickeys/calendar- Last month the lodge rental calendar went on line. Forms are there for both the lodge and little house. This seems user friendly and is working out well. We have many rentals this year!

Congrats! Special prize goes to Andy Militello -Congratulations! John invites you to take a table pumpkin centerpiece home!

***ON-GOING/UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

Lodge Beautification Program Update-Drew/Scott- The new roof is on, stucco work is nearly done and the mural has been started.

Paving project- Mark Warner thanks all for the prayers and meals! Mark and Scott shared about the paving project. Mark explains that they were looking for projects that could help lower our tax bill. We've had a 3-5 year plan for the paving project. Some of the work has already been done. The main parking lot still needs completed. Mark and Scott met with contractor that we've been using. We received an "end of year price" of \$2/ sf. 22000 sf. Totaling \$44,000. We are adding an additional \$3000 to address reworking all of the areas to redirect water away from the building. Totaling \$47,000. Parts of the parking lot are raised and are a trip hazard. Trip hazard area needs to be re-worked to transition better and have water redirected to a better area. There are large cracks needing repaired, asphalt, overlay and striped. The company would then return next year to seal and restripe. We've worked with him before and feel his work has held up and there is an 18 month warranty. Kevin Sorice made a motion to do the paving repair as Scott and Mark explained it. Seconded by Steve Torre. Discussion- We budgeted \$50,000 for maintenance this year. \$26,000 has been used thus far, leaving \$24,000. We'd need to use some money allotted for next year's maintenance to pay for this. Maria Rzecznik asks if they will rip out the flower beds? When will this start? This could potentially start tomorrow morning if approved tonight. We are also trying to navigate rentals/ parking etc. Jack asks how we feel about taking the money from next year? Gloria feels it is worth the ask of membership, due to the price break and tax advantage, it seems it is too good to pass up. Parking in the meantime discussed. Vote YES unanimously.


