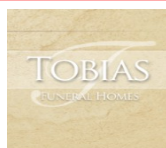

● MINUTES FROM PAST MEETING – No changes or revisions noted. Accepted into record.

● COMMUNICATIONS – Niki- None

● TREASURER'S REPORT – Charlie reports details on all account balances and activity. Reminder that the club mostly runs on Festa proceeds, and if something happens to Festa, after a few years, it would severely impact our ability to run. This is the reason we are building our endowment fund. This, not to have to rely on Festa in the future. In Societa have about \$100,000 to last us through festa this year, and we need more than that to run lodge. Sometime during summer, we'll likely have to move money (hopefully with no tax burden). We are not poor, but we have current available money earmarked. Charlie completed a spend plan and this was reviewed by council and the financial committee. This plan shows we are operating at a deficit this year. Don Carone asks What was our bleed rate? Last month was unusual, due to real estate taxes and the money spent for improvements. Don Carone asked what is the trend on endowment fund? Charlie shared that we grew over \$100,000 last year, with no money put in (increase due to market forces). Charlie summarizes that we earned about 10%. We have a desire/ need to increase this. We need about 15 years to bring our fund to where we need it to be, which we believe is needed to have the lodge run properly, regardless of Festa. Pete Petrini asked for clarification on when endowment fund was started, what is the annual revenue and what comes from Festa. The money is to provide for the continuation of the lodge. Due to fixing up the lodge- remodeling the bathrooms etc, donations to the endowment fund did not occur last year. Our plan is to run as lean as possible this year. Motion to accept into record by Tim Wallace Seconded by Rita Pinti Discussion: See above Voted yes unanimously.

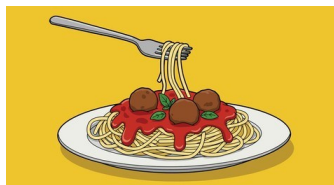

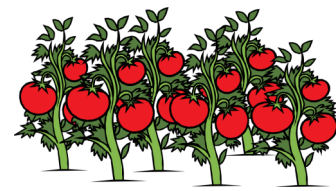
