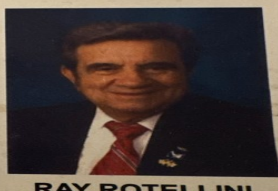

- **STATE and SUPREME LODGE UPDATE** – Brian Andzik here to share about state. Plenary session is next week.

On May 27th this year, Brian was invited to the White House and he went! He attended the dedication of the Columbus Statue/ fountain at Union Station. It has been inoperable for 20 years and this was part of the renovation of national monuments. Some political figures/ cabinet members were present also. We were happy to have OSDIA represented at this dedication. The NALA gala took place during the same visit to DC. They gave away \$250,000 in scholarships this year! The Commission for Social Justice continues work- please see the Italian American magazine for details and information. Other Italian organizations in the country are all starting to talk to each other. They are all conquering lots of issues. Motion by Jim Balsamo to accept into record. Seconded by Pat Catugno. Discussion: None Voted YES into record.

Buildings and Grounds: Drew brought attention to the fact that this room is QUIET. Drew's friend, a Mechanical Engineer, came to look at our heat and air conditioning system to give us advice on how to improve it. Why is there always a draft? There is a 30 in exhaust fan in the room that we used to use. He was asked why there is always a draft from the kitchen into the main hall? He discovered there is a 30 inch exhaust fan in the ceiling at the north end of the room that was used to draw in cool air before the building was air conditioned. It appears this fan has been running for perhaps the past 20 years. It is like having 2 windows open. We turned it OFF! Kitchen a/c, other maintenance items. Mark Warner explained about the HVAC issues and fix. Mark asked Charlie to track upcoming utility bills, as there should be a reduction. A few different ideas reviewed as a fix (another split system etc), Not recommended. Half the Kitchen was not getting cooled due to issues with old air handler which is sealed off now. They emptied the pantry for the new HVAC system installation. Marisa had a thermostat donation from her energy company- thank you. The Mech Eng recommended installing an outside makeup air vent in the new kitchen A/C system. Outside air is now being pulled vs inside. Gloria shared- this is deemed an emergency so council approved vs. coming to members first.**Lodge rentals-**Hickeys/calendar- none**Social-Belinda-** Tonight's 50/50 will benefit Cooley's Anemia. New members, we welcome your charity ideas for 50/50. We would like to keep local if possible. There are several upcoming events, more information coming soon.**Bocce Leagues-**Caitlin shared that their season is ending in 2 weeks. Thurs Sept 24th is the women's banquet. Cooking Demo Queens will be doing the banquet and will meet on Monday August 17th at 6pm to prep.**Angelo-**no report**Bocce Classic-Elaine** updates that this year, we battled the rain, heat and smoke! Shout out Brent McIntosh, Tim Pedro, Mark DeGrossa, Mark Warner, Pete Petrini, Ken Meine, Phil Levin, Libby Balsamo, Anne Beecroft, John Fantauzzo, Julia Hall, and Charlie Rigano. Elaine asks all who gave/ volunteered, participated, attended etc to stand up for a round of applause! We grossed \$19,104 with expenses of \$4465. We donated to \$4000 each to 2 charities; Ascension Greenmont Foodbank and Christ Child Society, with \$6120 coming back to the lodge. The Bocce Night Out, sold for \$700 dollars. Thank you, Brian and Andy, for buying the old signs. New Champs are the Space Cadets. (John Lombardo's team and MVP).**Festa-** Jim shared we are 1 month away from FESTA. Booth Chairs have parking passes. Please sign up to volunteer ASAP! We need multiple shifts covered. All booth chairs stand- Thank you all! We have a few yard signs if you need one. KEEP THEM for use in years to come. Festa Set up starts on Sept 5th, after Labor Day, then daily, all day, until festa. Festa clean up is Monday Sept 14th. Thank you, Chuck Levin, for continuing to coordinate volunteers from Lexis Nexis for clean-up crew. Julia Hall asks if you must be strong to help clean up? NO- Folks of all ages and abilities can be put to work! We'll feed you lunch too! Brian adds that Kettering PD will be here and helping guide traffic. Please be kind. Some volunteers have given them a hard time historically. If you cannot park at the club, please use Reynolds and Reynolds parking. We are doing all of this ourselves- our chairs and volunteers are the lifeblood of our festa All booths will take credit cards and cash this year (good back up)! Marcus Levin is leading the IT team around this. He'll provide training on this to folks also if needed.

Wi-Fi is strong and capable. There will be price increases this year. Some of our costs have tripled in the last several years and we need to be mindful of this and be fair and offer good value to the customers. Food prices will be determined the week prior to festa. Recycling and waste mgt have greatly improved. We are pursuing this more aggressively than other festivals. Entertainment is the same as in the last few years. Spread the word on Facebook and follow "The Italian Fall Festa" on Facebook. Instagram etc. There will be drones and live footage coming. Brian is working on arrangement with the Greek Festival, trying to get the Media to follow us to the Greek Festival, then bring their committee to our festival for a walk around etc. We want to offer the Greeks a "VIP" experience! This could be a great media event and a cross-cultural opportunity! National Delegation from OSDIA will be present this year also. This will be the largest group yet that will also get VIP treatment. Michelle Jahnke points out we were NOT on Living Dayton last year. Brian is working to fix this. We need help with advertising ahead of time. All help is appreciated! Jim shared that we are working on a ceremony to start off Festa with honoring 9/11. Best of Dayton and the Nomination process. When it opens- please let's all vote for us for the BEST FESTA! This will likely not be until April. Tim Wallace asked about strategic billboard ads? Nothing is off limits. Jake Bontatibus adds that last year Dayton Local had the WRONG DATE. With the Meatball Madness, we have reached out to the local school's cross-country teams. Kathy Klein (owns a gelato shop) suggests using TikTok videos! Tony Lacon here to highlight the Gelato Booth. He needs help with Sat and Sun am- 3-hour shifts! Please help! Jim- if you bought a bocce brick 2 years ago- we finally got them due to several snafus. If all goes well, bricks will be in place by Festa.

Katie Swiger thanks all to help make 10k+ cookies thus far. Next baking date is Aug 16th at 10am. COME ANY-TIME. We'll be making a new cookie- Ameretti. Cookie booth volunteers are needed on Saturday and Sunday. Katie in charge of cookies. Caitlin in charge of Cannoli's. Please keep this in mind when signing up for help. In any booth, we must remember we are eating in the correct locations and not out front as it is a health violation.

Kitchen Report – John thanks kitchen crew for riding solo last month. Mark Warner really stepped to help John! John offered Bocce classic "thank you's" to all that stayed and purchased items etc. Housekeeping for festa: Please continue to leave the lodge in BETTER condition than you found it.
